












- Hyvin soi! –music festival combines music and well-being.

- A free concert at 6 p.m. every Friday in June and July.
- Organised outdoors in a café in the park next to Vääksy river and the canal.
- Young musicians get the chance to perform in addition to visiting musicians.
- Organised by Asikkalanseudun Musiikkiopisto (ASMO), which is a local private music institute.









* Asikkala Youth Council organises together with the municipality's welfare officials a free festival for young people once a year.
* There is also an open stage for young local artists.
